IN ALMOST ALL OF THE WORLD, RURAL SCHOOLS HAD LESS COVERAGE OF BASIC SERVICES OF DRINKING WATER vs urban schools. In 2016, 1 in 4 elementary schools and 1 in 6 secondary schools, do NOT have them.

34 OUT OF 92 COUNTRIES DO NOT HAVE ACCESS to basic drinking water service in their schools.



IN 2016, 19% OF THE WORLD'S SCHOOLS had no drinking water service, which means that almost 570 million children throughout the world had limited or no drinking water service in their schools.
